Sample Curriculum Map Overview

Sigma Lambda Omega (SLO) chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. will expose students to arts enrichment and culture by focusing on visual and performing arts and by showcasing talent through the exploration of writers, entertainers, and various other artists.

- ***Salute to the Harlem Renaissance*** will celebrate the contributions of African-American artists during the 1920's Harlem Renaissance through student research and SLO sponsorship of student talent showcases. This initiative will correlate with Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and African-American culture.
- ***Salute to the Black Arts Movement*** will focus on student research and celebration of African-American artists during the 1960's and 1970's Black Arts Movement. SLO will champion activities that express the movement message and highlight members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority who served as leaders and participants. Activities will include art events, poetry competitions, dancing, visual art, and performing arts.

This curriculum is designed to educate and inspire students interested in the Arts by providing them with an immersive experience through the exploration of African-American artists from these two eras (Harlem Renaissance and the Black Arts Movements). Each student will have the opportunity to explore and share their interest in the arts through a series of workshops and activities that center on writers, visual arts, and theatre. Each workshop is designed to prepare the students to showcase their own creative works.

Curriculum duration: August 2019 - June 2022:

- Unit 1: Aug 2019 - Jun 2020 | Poetry and the Movements [Closed]
- Unit 2: Sep 2020 - Jun 2021 | Virtual Arts Program [Closed]
 - Introduction to the Harlem Renaissance and the Black Arts Movement, with emphasis on Art, Fashion, and Theatre.
- Unit 3: Sep 2021 - Jun 2022 | Drama and the Movements
 - Emphasis on Acting and Writing
